



SAFETY CERTIFICATION

Arch Deco Glass® is a participating member of the Safety Glazing Certification Council (SGCC), a non-profit corporation, established in 1971 by manufacturers of safety glazing products, building code officials and others concerned with public safety.

SGCC maintains a program that provides for the certification of safety glazing materials found to be in compliance with one or both of the following applications:

American National Standard for Safety Glazing Materials used in Buildings – Safety Performance Specifications and Methods of Test: ANSI Z97.1-2004.

Consumer Product Safety Commission Safety Standard for Architectural Glazing Materials – codified at Title 16, Part 1201 of the Code of Federal Regulations: 16 CFR:1201.

All fully Tempered Glass products will be manufactured in accordance with ASTM C-1048 and ANSI Z97.1-2004.

All Laminated Glass products will be manufactured in accordance with ANSI Z97.1-2004 , CPSC 16 CFR 1201 and ASTM C 1172.

All Insulating Glass products (i.e., Single Seal Polysulfide, Dual Seal Polyisobutylene primary/ Polysulfide secondary and Dual Seal silicone), will be manufactured in accordance with ASTM E2188 and ASTM E2190 Hig's Test and have been independently tested and certified as conforming to IGCC standards for Classes CBA.

These specifications subject safety glazing materials, used in buildings and architectural products, to practical tests designed to reduce or eliminate unreasonable risk of death and injury when safety glazing material is broken by human contact.
